\$5.6M Paving Improvements to begin on 1-25 Business Loop in T or C
Lane Closures will begin on Dec. 12

TRUTH OR CONSEQUENCES- The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One, in collaboration with Mountain States Constructors, Inc., is excited to announce a \$5.6M milling and paving project along the I-25 Business Loop on Date Street, Broadway and Main Street. The paving and milling project will improve the entire loop, which is 5.5 miles.

Starting Thursday, December 12, 2024, drivers can expect lane closures beginning at the ramps of Interstate Exit 79 (T or C North) and extending toward the roundabouts. One lane of traffic will remain open throughout the duration and access to all businesses and residences will be maintained during construction. Work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. This phase of construction is anticipated to take two months, depending on weather conditions. Paving will continue to the remaining sections of Date, Broadway & Main Streets after the holidays.
