\$5.6M Paving improvements project
I-25 Business Loop in T or C

TRUTH OR CONSEQUENCES - The New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) District One, in collaboration with Mountain States Constructors, Inc., is completing the \$5.6M milling and paving project along the I-25 Business Loop on Date Street, Broadway and Main Street. The paving and milling project will improve the entire loop, which is 5.5 miles.

Drivers can expect lane closures from the roundabouts on Date St., to the Interstate Exit 75 (Williamsburg) and will include operations on Broadway and Main Street. One lane of traffic will remain open throughout the duration and access to all businesses and residences will be maintained during construction, some areas may require a detour. Work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., daily.

Daily construction activities may require residents and businesses to temporarily adjust their parking. Prompt vehicle relocation will help speed up paving operations in the area.
